

# QPP MIPS 2019

## Promoting Interoperability (PI) Hardship Exception for Small Practices

If you are a MIPS eligible clinician you may apply for a reweighting\* for one of the following reasons:

- MIPS-eligible clinicians in small practices
- MIPS-eligible clinicians using decertified EHR technology
- Insufficient internet connectivity
- Extreme and uncontrollable circumstances
- Lack of control over the availability of CERHT

\*The 25 percent weighting of the [Promoting Interoperability](#) performance category would be reallocated to the Quality performance category.

If you are an **INDIVIDUAL CLINICIAN**:

- Add Individual NPI
- Add Clinicians First Name
- Add Clinicians Last Name

If you are a part of a **GROUP (2+)**:

- Add Group TIN

### Section #1 – Submitter/Third Party Intermediary Information

- Submitter add *your* **First Name**
- Submitter add *your* **Last Name**
- Submitter add *your* **Email Address**
- Submitter add *your* **Phone w/ Area Code**
- Submitter add *your* **Relationship to Clinician or Practice**
- Check Off** that you are authorized to submit this application on behalf of Clinician or Practice

### Section #2.5 - Small Practice

- Check Off “**Small Practice**”

### Section #3 – Certification Statement for QPP Application

- Check Off “**Certify**”
- Add Name of Individual Completing Form
- Click on “Submit”
- You should then receive an email stating “**Application is Approved**”

**Must submit application by December 31<sup>st</sup> 2019**
