## 4 Tips for Successful Quality Payment Program Reporting

### 1) Determine Eligibility

Check out QPP Participation Status look up tool: <https://qpp.cms.gov/participation-lookup>

### 2) Select Measures and Activities

Check your local medical societies and specialty societies to select more meaningful measures and activates according to your specialty. Make sure measures are available according to submission type, such as claims, registry, EHR, QCDR.

### 3) Collect Data

Did you know providers in small practices (15 or fewer eligible clinicians) can apply to have their Promoting Interoperability score re-weighted? The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) understands the burden on small practices to meet the CEHRT criteria for reporting to the Promoting Interoperability component of MIPS. CMS provides this option as a way to report to MIPS, avoid penalties, and possibly earn a small positive payment adjustment.

### 4) Report Data

To help small practices succeed in MIPS in 2019, CMS is continuing the small practice bonus. The bonus is in the Quality performance score of clinicians instead of as a standalone bonus. CMS is also awarding small practices three points for quality measures that don't meet data completeness requirements.
